The House Committee on Appropriations reported through REP. MERRILL of the 54th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the resolution ought to be adopted.

***RESOLUTION PROPOSING APPROVAL OF A STIPULATED AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE SERVICES AND THE PROTECTIVE SERVICES EMPLOYEES COALITION.***

Resolved by this House:

- 1 That the collective bargaining agreement between the Department
- 2 of Revenue Services and the Protective Services Employees Coalition,
- 3 IUPA/IAFF, AFL-CIO, concerning overtime payments for special
- 4 enforcement agents, submitted to this assembly June 30, 2005, for
- 5 approval, as provided in subsection (b) of section 5-278 of the general
- 6 statutes, is approved.

**Municipal Impact:** None

**Explanation**

The resolution will not result in a cost to the Department of Revenue Services (DRS), as funding of \$7,000 is provided by a federal grant. The agents will be participating in International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA) enforcement activity with the State Police and the Department of Motor Vehicles. Tax Enforcement Special Agents in DRS will be aiding in the audit of mileage receipts from motor carriers who drive through Connecticut. Such audits are to enforce compliance of the IFTA that requires motor carriers to report to the federal government the number of miles they have driven.

Under the current collective bargaining agreement, Tax Enforcement Special Agents are not entitled to overtime payment. However, under the terms of this stipulated agreement, agents are entitled to receive overtime payment for participating in this project.

**The Out Years**

This stipulated agreement is effective from July 1, 2005 - June 30, 2010, or upon exhaustion of the \$7,000 federal grant.
