AN ACT EXEMPTING BIODIESEL FUEL FROM THE MOTOR VEHICLE FUELS TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-458f of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that any diesel fuel blend containing fifty per cent or greater biodiesel
- 3 fuel be included in the alternative fuels not subject to the motor vehicle

4 fuels tax.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage economic development in the production of environmentally-friendly products by providing a tax incentive for the use of fuels that will reduce greenhouse gas emissions and reduce dependence on fossil fuels.
