AN ACT RESTORING FUNDS FOR THE TOWN AID FOR ROADS PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 13a-175a of the general statutes is repealed and
2 the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2006*):

3 For each fiscal year there shall be allocated [twelve] twenty-two
4 million five hundred thousand dollars out of the funds appropriated to
5 the Department of Transportation, or from any other source, not
6 otherwise prohibited by law, to be used by the towns for construction,
7 reconstruction, improvement or maintenance of highways, sections of
8 highways, bridges or structures incidental to highways and bridges or
9 the improvement thereof, including the plowing of snow, the sanding
10 of icy pavements, the trimming and removal of trees, the installation,
11 replacement and maintenance of traffic signs, signals and markings,
12 and for traffic control and vehicular safety programs, traffic and
13 parking planning and administration, and other purposes and
14 programs related to highways, traffic and parking, and for the
15 purposes of providing and operating essential public transportation
16 services and related facilities.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	July 1, 2006	13a-175a
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Statement of Purpose:

To provide increased financial support for road improvements in Connecticut municipalities.
