AN ACT CONTROLLING THE SALE OF METHAMPHETAMINE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2006*) Any person who sells or
2 offers for sale at retail any drug product or combination of drug
3 products containing ephedrine, psuedoephedrine or
4 phenylpropanolamine, or their salts, isomers or salts of isomers, shall
5 (1) store such drug products or combination of drug products in a
6 location that is inaccessible to consumers, and (2) require consumers to
7 request and purchase such drug products or combination of drug
8 products at the counter.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
