AN ACT CONCERNING THE SUSPENSION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE FOR THE PURCHASE OR POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR BY A MINOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 14-111e of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2006*):

3 (a) The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall suspend, for a period
4 of [one hundred fifty] thirty days, the motor vehicle operator's license
5 or nonresident operating privilege of any person under the age of
6 twenty-one who has been convicted of a violation of section 30-88a
7 involving the misuse of an operator's license or section 30-89 involving
8 the purchase and possession of alcoholic liquor by a minor.

9 (b) Any person under the age of twenty-one who has not been
10 issued a motor vehicle operator's license under section 14-36, as
11 amended, and who has been convicted of a violation of section 30-88a
12 involving the misuse of an operator's license, section 30-89 involving
13 the purchase and possession of alcoholic liquor by a minor or
14 subsection (e) of section 1-1h, as amended, involving the misuse of an

15 identity card, shall not be issued a new operator's license by the
16 commissioner under section 14-36, as amended, until a period of [one
17 hundred fifty] thirty days has elapsed from the date all applicable
18 requirements for any such license have been satisfied by the applicant.

19 (c) The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall suspend, for a period
20 of ninety days, the motor vehicle operator's license or nonresident
21 operating privilege of any person who has been convicted of a
22 violation of section 30-87, involving inducing minors to procure liquor
23 or section 30-86, involving the sale of alcoholic liquor to a minor.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce the license suspension period for minors convicted of misuse of an operator's license or purchase and possession of alcoholic liquor by a minor and to suspend the motor vehicle licenses of persons convicted of inducing minors to procure liquor or selling alcohol to a minor.
