Substitute Bill No. 5557

AN ACT CONCERNING THE SUSPENSION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE FOR THE PURCHASE OR POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR BY A MINOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 14-111e of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2006*):

3 (a) The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall suspend, for a period
4 of one hundred fifty days, the motor vehicle operator's license or
5 nonresident operating privilege of any person under the age of twenty-
6 one who has been convicted of a violation of section 30-88a involving
7 the misuse of an operator's license or subsection (a) of section 30-89
8 involving the purchase [and possession] of alcoholic liquor by a minor.
9 The commissioner shall suspend for a period of thirty days, the motor
10 vehicle operator's license or nonresident operating privilege of any
11 person under the age of twenty-one who has been convicted two or
12 more times of a violation of subsection (b) of section 30-89 involving
13 the possession of alcoholic liquor by a minor.

14 (b) Any person under the age of twenty-one who has not been
15 issued a motor vehicle operator's license under section 14-36, as
16 amended, and who has been convicted of a violation of section 30-88a
17 involving the misuse of an operator's license, subsection (a) of section
18 30-89 involving the purchase [and possession] of alcoholic liquor by a

19 minor or subsection (e) of section 1-1h, as amended, involving the
20 misuse of an identity card, shall not be issued a new operator's license
21 by the commissioner under section 14-36, as amended, until a period of
22 one hundred fifty days has elapsed from the date all applicable
23 requirements for any such license have been satisfied by the applicant.
24 Any person under the age of twenty-one who has not been issued a
25 motor vehicle operator's license under said section 14-36 and who has
26 been convicted two or more times of a violation of subsection (b) of
27 section 30-89 involving the possession of alcoholic liquor by a minor
28 shall not be issued a new operator's license by the commissioner under
29 said section 14-36 until a period of thirty days has elapsed from the
30 date all applicable requirements for any such license have been
31 satisfied by the applicant.

32 (c) The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall suspend, for a period
33 of ninety days, the motor vehicle operator's license or nonresident
34 operating privilege of any person who has been convicted of a
35 violation of section 30-87, involving inducing minors to procure liquor
36 or section 30-86, involving the sale of alcoholic liquor to a minor.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
