AN ACT EXEMPTING SALES OF MEALS AT HONOR BOXES FROM THE SALES TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (27) of section 12-412 of the 2006 supplement
2 to the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in
3 lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2006, and applicable to sales occurring on*
4 *or after October 1, 2006*):

5 (27) (A) Sales of any items for fifty cents or less from vending
6 machines; or (B) [sales of food products, as defined in subsection (13)
7 of this section,] notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (13) of
8 this section, meals sold through coin-operated vending machines or at
9 unattended "honor boxes".

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>October 1, 2006, and applicable to sales occurring on or after October 1, 2006</i>	12-412(27)

Statement of Purpose:

To exempt meals sold from an "honor box" from the sales tax.
