**AN ACT INCREASING THE SUBSIDY FOR HEALTH INSURANCE
PREMIUMS FOR CERTAIN RETIRED TEACHERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 10-183t of the 2006 supplement to
2 the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
3 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2006*):

4 (c) On and after July 1, [2000] 2006, the board shall pay a subsidy
5 [equal to the subsidy paid in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000,] in
6 the amount of two hundred twenty dollars to the board of education
7 or to the state, if applicable, on behalf of any member who is receiving
8 retirement benefits or a disability allowance from the system, or the
9 spouse, or the surviving spouse of such member, or a disabled
10 dependent of such member if there is no spouse or surviving spouse,
11 who is participating in a health insurance plan maintained by a board
12 of education or by the state, if applicable. [Such payment] On and after
13 July 1, 2007, the amount of the subsidy for any member who is
14 ineligible for Medicare shall be increased by the percentage increase in
15 the national Consumer Price Index for Health Care for the previous
16 calendar year, but shall not exceed the actual cost of such insurance.
17 With respect to any person participating in any such plan pursuant to
18 subsection (b) of this section, the state shall appropriate to the board
19 one-third of the cost of the subsidy. No payment to a board of

20 education pursuant to this subsection may be used to reduce the
21 amount of any premium payment on behalf of any such member,
22 spouse or surviving spouse, or disabled dependent, made by such
23 board pursuant to any agreement in effect on July 1, 1990.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
