**AN ACT CONCERNING LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT FUNDING.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2006*) Whenever any person is  
2 convicted of a violation of section 14-213, 14-213b, 14-214, 14-215, 14-  
3 215a, 14-216, 14-218a, 14-219, 14-220, 14-221, 14-222, 14-222a, 14-223, 14-  
4 223a, 14-224, 14-225, 14-227a, 14-230, 14-230a, 14-231, 14-232, 14-233, 14-  
5 234, 14-235, 14-236, 14-237, 14-238, 14-238a, 14-239, 14-240, 14-240a, 14-  
6 241, 14-242, 14-243, 14-244, 14-245, 14-246a, 14-247, 14-247a, 14-248a, 14-  
7 249, 14-250, 14-250a, 14-257, 14-261, 14-262, 14-262a, 14-264, 14-266, 14-  
8 267a, 14-269, 14-270, 14-271, 14-272a, 14-273, 14-274, 14-279, 14-281a,  
9 subsection (e) or (g) of section 14-283, section 14-289a or 14-289b of the  
10 general statutes, the court, in addition to imposing any fine authorized  
11 by said sections for such violation, shall impose a surcharge in an  
12 amount equal to twenty per cent of such fine. Any such surcharge  
13 collected shall be payable to the municipality in which the arrest was  
14 made to be used for local law enforcement funding.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	October 1, 2006	New section
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**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide funding for local law enforcement.
