AN ACT CONCERNING CELLULAR MOBILE TELEPHONE RECORDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of
2 Consumer Protection shall adopt regulations, in accordance with
3 chapter 54 of the general statutes, prohibiting the sale of consumer
4 cellular mobile telephone records by cellular mobile telephone
5 companies to third parties and prohibiting the sale or disclosure of
6 such records by such third parties.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
