**AN ACT CONCERNING PRICE GOUGING AND NOTIFICATION OF A DECLARED STATE OF EMERGENCY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) A natural person, trade  
2 association, corporation or other entity may register with the  
3 Commissioner of Consumer Protection as an agent for purposes of  
4 being notified in the event of a declaration by the Governor of a state  
5 of emergency. Such natural person, trade association, corporation or  
6 other entity shall be notified in an expeditious manner when the  
7 Governor declares a state of emergency and when such declaration is  
8 rescinded.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
