AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY TO ENHANCE THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF BLACK AND HISPANIC MALE STUDENTS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2006*) The Department of Education shall
2 conduct a study to determine how the public school system can work
3 to reduce the high school drop-out and suspension rates and the
4 incarceration rate of black and Hispanic male students. Not later than
5 January 1, 2007, the department shall report its findings to the joint
6 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
7 matters relating to education in accordance with the provision of
8 section 11-4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>July 1, 2006</i>	New section
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Statement of Purpose:

To require the Department of Education to study ways to reduce the high school drop-out and suspension rates and the incarceration rate of black and Hispanic students.
