***AN ACT CONCERNING A COMMUNITY-TECHNICAL COLLEGE
TRANSFER INCENTIVE PROGRAM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2006*) (a) There is established a
2 community-technical college transfer incentive scholarship program
3 administered by the Department of Higher Education.

4 (b) The program shall provide scholarships for students who are
5 graduates of a community-technical college entering or enrolling in
6 The University of Connecticut, Charter Oak State College or a
7 university in the Connecticut State University system. No scholarship
8 shall exceed the combined costs of tuition and fees of the institution at
9 which the scholarship recipient is or will be enrolled. The Department
10 of Higher Education shall develop eligibility requirements for
11 recipients. Such requirements shall include income guidelines.
12 Students shall be eligible for such scholarships for each year they are
13 enrolled at such college or university for a total of not more than two
14 years per student. Students may apply for such scholarships to the
15 Department of Higher Education at such time and in such manner as
16 the Commissioner of Higher Education prescribes.

17 Sec. 2. (*Effective July 1, 2006*) The sum of three million two hundred
18 thousand dollars is appropriated to the Department of Education, from
19 the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, for

20 Connecticut Aid for Public College Students, and shall be used for the
21 purposes of carrying out the provisions of section 1 of this act.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
