**AN ACT REQUIRING REPRESENTATION OF THE CAPITAL CITY  
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY ON THE CONNECTICUT  
COMMISSION ON CULTURE AND TOURISM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 10-393 of the general statutes is  
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
3 *October 1, 2006*):

4 (a) The Connecticut Commission on Culture and Tourism shall  
5 consist of [twenty-nine] thirty voting commissioners and nonvoting  
6 ex-officio members. Such ex-officio members shall be the executive  
7 directors of the Connecticut Trust for Historic Preservation and the  
8 Connecticut Humanities Council; [ ] a member of the board of  
9 directors of the Capital City Economic Development Authority, as  
10 chose by said board; the State Poet Laureate; [ ] the State Historian and  
11 the State Archaeologist. The State Poet Laureate, the State Historian  
12 and the State Archaeologist shall serve as commissioners without  
13 being appointed and without receiving compensation for such service.  
14 The remaining twenty-four commissioners shall be appointed as  
15 follows:

16 (1) The Governor shall appoint eight commissioners: (A) One  
17 commissioner shall be an individual with knowledge of or experience  
18 or interest in tourism from within the state; (B) three commissioners

19 shall be individuals with knowledge of or experience or interest in  
20 history or humanities; (C) one commissioner shall be an individual  
21 with knowledge of or experience or interest in the arts; (D) one  
22 commissioner shall be an individual with knowledge of or experience  
23 or interest in film; and (E) two commissioners shall be selected at large.

24 (2) The speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint three  
25 commissioners: (A) One commissioner shall be an individual with  
26 knowledge of or experience or interest in tourism from the  
27 southwestern tourism district, established under section 10-397; (B)  
28 one commissioner shall be an individual with knowledge of or  
29 experience or interest in history or humanities; and (C) one  
30 commissioner shall be an individual with knowledge of or experience  
31 or interest in the arts.

32 (3) The president pro tempore of the Senate shall appoint three  
33 commissioners: (A) One commissioner shall be an individual with  
34 knowledge of or experience or interest in tourism from the central  
35 tourism district, established under section 10-397; (B) one  
36 commissioner shall be an individual with knowledge of or experience  
37 or interest in history or humanities; and (C) one commissioner shall be  
38 an individual with knowledge of or experience or interest in the arts.

39 (4) The majority leader of the House of Representatives shall  
40 appoint two commissioners: (A) One commissioner shall be an  
41 individual with knowledge of or experience or interest in tourism from  
42 the south central tourism district, established under section 10-397; and  
43 (B) one commissioner shall be an individual with knowledge of or  
44 experience or interest in the arts.

45 (5) The majority leader of the Senate shall appoint two  
46 commissioners: (A) One commissioner shall be an individual with  
47 knowledge of or experience or interest in tourism from the eastern  
48 tourism district; and (B) one commissioner shall be an individual with  
49 knowledge of or experience or interest in the arts.

50 (6) The minority leader of the House of Representatives shall

51 appoint three commissioners: (A) One commissioner shall be an  
52 individual with knowledge of or experience or interest in tourism from  
53 within the state; (B) one commissioner shall be an individual with  
54 knowledge of or experience or interest in history or humanities; and  
55 (C) one commissioner shall be an individual with knowledge of or  
56 experience or interest in the arts.

57 (7) The minority leader of the Senate shall appoint three  
58 commissioners: (A) One commissioner shall be an individual with  
59 knowledge of or experience or interest in tourism from the  
60 northwestern tourism district, established under section 10-397; (B) one  
61 commissioner shall be an individual with knowledge of or experience  
62 or interest in history or humanities; and (C) one commissioner shall be  
63 an individual with knowledge of or experience or interest in the arts.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
