**AN ACT DESIGNATING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER AS LUNG
CANCER AWARENESS MONTH.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 10-29a of the 2006 supplement to
2 the general statutes is amended by adding subdivision (51) as follows
3 (*Effective October 1, 2006*):

4 (NEW) (51) Lung Cancer Awareness Month. The Governor shall
5 proclaim the month of November to be Lung Cancer Awareness
6 Month to heighten public awareness of the fact that lung cancer is the
7 leading cause of cancer death of both men and women in the United
8 States. Suitable exercises shall be held in the State Capitol and
9 elsewhere as the Governor designates for the observance of the month.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:
