AN ACT CONCERNING WRECKER REGISTRATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (98) of subsection (a) of section 14-1 of the
2 2006 supplement to the general statutes is repealed and the following
3 is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2006*):

4 (98) "Wrecker" means a vehicle which is registered, designed,
5 equipped and used for the purposes of towing or transporting
6 wrecked or disabled motor vehicles for compensation or for related
7 purposes by a person, firm or corporation licensed in accordance with
8 the provisions of subpart (D) of part III of this chapter or a vehicle
9 contracted for the consensual towing or transporting of a motor vehicle
10 to or from a place of sale, purchase, salvage or repair.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To allow a registered wrecker to tow or transport motor vehicles to or from a place of sale, purchase or repair pursuant to a contract with the vehicle owner or owners.
