AN ACT CONCERNING CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY CAMPUS TRAFFIC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 10a-92 of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

3 The Board of Trustees of the Connecticut State University System
4 shall appoint a committee at each campus to establish traffic and
5 parking regulations for passenger vehicles on such campus. Such
6 traffic committee, subject to the approval of said board and of the State
7 Traffic Commission, may prohibit, limit or restrict the parking of
8 passenger vehicles, determine speed limits, install stop signs, restrict
9 roads or portions thereof to one-way traffic and designate the location
10 of crosswalks on any portion of any road or highway subject to the
11 care, custody and control of said board of trustees, order to have
12 erected and maintained signs designating such prohibitions or
13 restrictions, and impose a fine upon any person who fails to comply
14 with any such prohibition or restriction. Violation of any provision of
15 this section shall be an infraction. All fines so imposed at each state
16 university, less an amount not to exceed the cost of enforcing traffic

17 and parking regulations, shall be deposited in the institutional
18 operating account of such state university for scholarships and library
19 services or acquisitions. The Board of Trustees of the Connecticut State
20 University System shall establish at each campus a committee which
21 shall hear appeals of penalties assessed for parking or traffic violations.
22 The membership of both the committee to establish traffic and parking
23 regulations and the committee to hear traffic violation appeals shall
24 include student and faculty representation.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To allow traffic authorities at each state university campus to install stop signs.
