AN ACT CONCERNING THE POSTING OF AGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SENIOR DISCOUNTS AT RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2006*) Any person who offers
2 goods or services to the public at retail and who offers a discount to
3 senior citizens shall disclose the qualifying age and the percentage of
4 such discount on a conspicuously placed sign located at the point of
5 display, the cash register or store entrance, as applicable. A violation of
6 this section shall constitute an unfair or deceptive trade practice under
7 subsection (a) of section 42-110b of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
