**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MOLD
ABATEMENT PROTOCOL.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) On or before October 1,
2 2006, the Department of Public Health shall adopt regulations, in
3 accordance with chapter 54 of the general statutes, establishing a mold
4 abatement protocol for persons who hold themselves out to the public
5 as mold remediation or abatement contractors. Such protocol shall
6 include, but need not be limited to, specific, acceptable methods for
7 performing mold remediation or abatement work.
- 8 (b) No person may engage in mold remediation or abatement work
9 in this state for a fee or other remuneration unless such person adheres
10 to the mold abatement protocol established pursuant to subsection (a)
11 of this section.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section
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Statement of Purpose:

To require the Department of Public Health to establish a protocol for mold abatement and to require mold abatement contractors to adhere to such protocol.
