"AN ACT CONCERNING GAMING PRODUCTS AND RAFFLE PRIZES."

1 Before line 1, insert the following and renumber remaining sections
2 and internal references accordingly:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) Notwithstanding the
4 deadline for the presentation to the Connecticut Lottery Corporation of
5 a winning lottery ticket to claim a prize for any Lotto lottery game, any
6 person who presents any winning Lotto lottery ticket no later than
7 seventy-two hours after the end of the time period for presenting
8 claims for any lottery game expiring on or after July 1, 1996, may file a
9 claim for such prize until August 1, 2006. Upon such application, said
10 corporation shall award such prize as follows: Ninety per cent of such
11 prize shall be paid to such person, and ten per cent of such prize shall
12 be paid to the Division of Special Revenue.

13 (b) The Division of Special Revenue shall use any funds received
14 pursuant to subsection (a) of this section to (1) conduct state and
15 national criminal history records checks pursuant to section 12-568a of

16 the general statutes, as amended by this act, and (2) fund the purchase
17 by the state of sheets of coupons, as required pursuant to subsection (e)
18 of section 7-185 of the general statutes, as amended by this act.

19 Sec. 2. Section 12-568a of the general statutes is repealed and the
20 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2006*):

21 (a) The Division of Special Revenue shall adopt regulations, in
22 accordance with chapter 54, for the purpose of assuring the integrity of
23 the state lottery, concerning the regulation of the state lottery under
24 the operation and management of the Connecticut Lottery
25 Corporation. Such regulations shall include: (1) The licensing of
26 employees of the Connecticut Lottery Corporation and any person or
27 business organization awarded the primary contract by said
28 corporation to provide facilities, components, goods or services which
29 are necessary for the operation of the activities authorized by chapter
30 229a; (2) the approval of procedures of the corporation; (3) the time
31 period for complying with the regulations governing said approval of
32 procedures; (4) offerings of lottery games; (5) minimum prize payouts
33 and payments; (6) regulation of lottery sales agents including
34 qualifications for licensure and grounds for license suspension and
35 revocation; (7) assurance of the integrity of the state lottery including
36 the computer gaming system, computer internal control and system
37 testing; and (8) limitations on advertising and marketing content to
38 assure public information as to the odds of winning the lottery and the
39 prohibition of sales of tickets to minors.

40 (b) The regulations adopted pursuant to subdivision (6) of
41 subsection (a) of this section shall include a requirement that each
42 applicant for an initial license as a lottery sales agent and an employee
43 designated by the applicant to oversee lottery sales for the applicant
44 submit to state and national criminal history records checks conducted
45 in accordance with section 29-17a of the 2006 supplement to the
46 general statutes before such license is issued."
