5 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Not later than January 1,
6 2007, and annually thereafter, the Department of Environmental
7 Protection shall submit a report regarding fishers to the joint standing
8 committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
9 relating to the environment and planning and development, in
10 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.
11 Such report shall include all available and relevant data involving
12 fishers within the state of Connecticut, including, but not limited to,
13 any reports of fisher sightings, the number of any attacks of domestic
14 animals by fishers and the details regarding any such attack, data
15 regarding the fisher population increase or decrease, as the case may

16 be, and the location of fishers within the state of Connecticut."
