1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2006*) A pharmacist licensed  
4 pursuant to chapter 400j of the general statutes or his or her agent shall  
5 require the presentation of valid photographic identification prior to  
6 releasing a controlled substance to any person not known to such  
7 pharmacist. The provisions of this section shall not apply in an  
8 institutional setting or to a long-term care facility, including, but not  
9 limited to, an assisted living facility or a hospital."
