Title: AN ACT CONCERNING FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE FOR STATE EMPLOYEES, SERVICES FOR INDIVIDUALS EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER IN THE CARE AND SUPERVISION OF THE COMMISSIONER OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES, PERMANENCY PLANS FOR CHILDREN, AND EMPLOYMENT ACCOMMODATIONS FOR MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

Statement of Purpose: To provide a leave of absence for state employees due to the serious illness of a foster child, provided such leave does not exceed four weeks during any one-year period.
