Title: AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS TO THE UTILITY STATUTES.

Statement of Purpose: To revise the current notice provisions regarding a rate amendment proceeding to encourage customer participation in such proceedings; to expand the listing of federal agencies that the Department of Public Utility Control may, with the approval of the Attorney General, obtain outside counsel in order to participate in such agencies' proceedings; to shift the burden of obtaining customer consent for the release of certain information from the electric distribution companies to the electric supply companies; to clarify language regarding the determination of the appropriate level of interest on a security deposit received by a public service company; to extend the time period for the Department of Public Utility Control to make a preliminary finding on the validity of a utility employee's complaint regarding their employer's misconduct from thirty business days to sixty business days; to clarify language regarding notification of customers by utilities of pending termination of service.
