Title: AN ACT CONCERNING EXTENDED REPORTING PERIOD COVERAGE UNDER MEDICAL MALPRACTICE INSURANCE POLICIES.

Statement of Purpose: To provide that prior acts coverage be consistent with any contractually agreed upon retroactive date; to eliminate the requirement that the insured is over the age of fifty-five; and to require that the insured has been insured by the insurer for the five consecutive years immediately preceding the discontinuance, in lieu of seven consecutive years.
