Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.

Statement of Purpose: To allow the Department of Correction to receive revenue from the contract that provides telephone service for inmates, permit the sale of body armor to authorized officials of the Department of Correction and the Board of Pardons and Paroles, revise the calculation for earning presentence confinement credit for unpaid fines, repeal the statute concerning the Alternatives to Incarceration Advisory Committee and repeal the statute mandating that men and women be confined separately.
