Title: AN ACT CONCERNING PROGRAMS ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES.

Statement of Purpose: To: (1) Revise income eligibility procedures used by the Department of Social Services in program eligibility determinations, (2) prohibit physicians groups affiliated with hospitals that receive disproportionate share payments from discriminating against persons on the basis of source of payment, (3) increase payment rates to private providers contracting with the state for the provision of human services, (4) expand the availability of state insurance payments on behalf of persons with acquired immunodeficiency syndrome or human immunodeficiency virus, (5) establish a residential care home pilot program for persons with income that exceeds three hundred per cent of the federal supplemental security income limit, and (6) provide appropriations to the Department of Social Services for the establishment of a dedicated call center for Medicaid recipients.
