**Statement of Purpose:** To provide seven million dollars of funding to the Department of Environmental Protection to administer and oversee the Ox Brook flood project and to purchase or protect adjacent lands or lands associated with the project as open space, seven million dollars to the Department of Environmental Protection to administer and oversee the Island Brook flood project and five million dollars to the Department of Environmental Protection to administer and oversee the Northeast flood project and to allow the Commissioner of Environmental Protection to charge the bond fund accounts the reasonable costs of administering the projects.
