Title: AN ACT CONCERNING NOTIFICATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF REARREST WARRANTS.

Statement of Purpose: To ensure that law enforcement agencies exercise due diligence and do not unreasonably delay the execution of rearrest warrants and arrest warrants for probation violations by requiring the law enforcement agencies to indicate in the PRAWN system the actions they have taken to execute the warrants.
