Title: AN ACT CONCERNING CRIME VICTIMS.

Statement of Purpose: To require a plaintiff in a civil action who has been convicted of a crime against the defendant to file a certificate that such civil action has merit and is not being brought maliciously or to harass the defendant, provide the Office of Victim Services flexibility in the payment of compensation to crime victims and authorize a court to order that court fees and costs be paid over time by indigent inmates or that such fees and costs not be waived.
