Title: AN ACT CONCERNING DELINQUENT MOTOR VEHICLE PROPERTY TAXES.

Statement of Purpose: To change the date by which towns are notified of the amounts they are required to pay the Department of Motor Vehicles in order to participate in that department's motor vehicle property tax delinquency enforcement program and to allow tax collectors to charge a fee of one dollar for each of a taxpayer's motor vehicles that a tax collector reports as delinquent in property tax payments to the department, and for which a notice of release is issued concerning the payment of a delinquent tax.
