Title: AN ACT CONCERNING VIOLATION OF THE CONNECTICUT BUSINESS OPPORTUNITY INVESTMENT ACT.

Statement of Purpose: To specifically authorize the Banking Commissioner to order persons that have violated the Connecticut Business Opportunity Investment Act to cease and desist and to increase the maximum fine from ten thousand dollars to one hundred thousand dollars per violation.
