Title: AN ACT CONCERNING STATEMENTS MADE IN APPLICATIONS FOR INDIVIDUAL HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES.

Statement of Purpose: To provide that health insurance carriers may refuse insurance coverage if the applicant's application contains deliberately deceptive misstatements and such misstatements materially affected the insurer's acceptance of the risk or the hazard assumed by the insurer.
