Title: AN ACT CONCERNING CHILD CARE.

Statement of Purpose: To: (1) Modify the definition of home health care agency to allow reimbursement under the Medicaid program for children who require therapies, to receive such therapies at facilities providing child day care services or after school programs, establish parity in the rates paid to state-funded child care centers and school readiness programs, and (2) increase reimbursement rates paid to state-funded child care centers and providers of child care services participating in the child care subsidy program.
