Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES, ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES AND OTHER MOTOR VEHICLES WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR OR ANY DRUG.

Statement of Purpose: To provide that persons who operate snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or any drug are subject to the same penalties as persons who operate automobiles while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or any drug including the suspension of their motor vehicle operator's licenses, and to make the prohibition on operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or any drug applicable regardless of where the motor vehicle is being operated.
