
I am respectfully requesting that you extend your support in favor of these two bills currently before the legislature. Bill #5650 has been voted to the Appropriations Committee and an accurate fiscal analysis will document that there is no immediate fiscal impact on the State's budget and the long-term impact will be extremely minor. Bill #675 is essentially the same as Bill #5650.

Approval of these bills will have a positive impact for us clericals who have withstood the inequality of benefits extended to those working in correctional facilities.
