1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2006*) A pharmacist licensed  
4 pursuant to chapter 400j of the general statutes shall obtain valid  
5 photographic identification prior to releasing a controlled substance to  
6 any person not known to such pharmacist. The provisions of this  
7 section shall not apply in an institutional setting or to a long-term care  
8 facility, including, but not limited to, an assisted living facility or a  
9 hospital."
