PRIOR TO THE EUTHANIZATION OF DOGS."**

5 circumstances shall the dog be euthanized if the dog was protecting
6 itself, its owner, its custodian, a member of its household, its kennel or
7 its offspring. The commissioner shall provide the owner of the dog
8 which has bitten and killed another dog with not less than fifteen days
9 notice of the owner's right to request a hearing prior to the euthanizing
10 of the dog. Upon completion of a hearing and issuance of a euthanasia
11 order, such owner shall have forty-five days within which to appeal
12 the order to the appropriate Superior Court in accordance with section
13 4-183 of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act. Upon the filing of

14 a notice of appeal, the euthanasia order shall be automatically stayed
15 pending final determination of the appeal. The owner of such dog shall
16 pay all impoundment costs unless the owner prevails at the hearing or
17 on appeal."
