**"RESOLUTION PROPOSING A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT
CONCERNING FUNDING OF THE CONNECTICUT TEACHERS'
RETIREMENT SYSTEM."**

1 After line 45, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 2. Article eleventh of the constitution is amended by adding
3 the following section:

4 (NEW) Sec. 6. One quarter of one per cent of the proceeds from the
5 sales tax shall be used for the purchase and preservation of open space
6 and farmlands.

7 RESOLVED: That the foregoing proposed amendment to the
8 Constitution be continued to the next session of the General Assembly
9 elected at the general election to be held on November 7, 2006, and
10 published with the laws passed at the present session, or be presented
11 to the electors at the general election to be held on November 7, 2006,
12 whichever the case may be, according to article sixth of the

13 amendments to the Constitution. The designation of said proposed
14 amendment to be used on the voting machine ballot labels and
15 absentee ballots at such election shall be "Shall the Constitution of the
16 State be amended to dedicate one-quarter of one per cent of the
17 proceeds from the sales tax to the purchase and preservation of open
18 space and farmlands?"
