"AN ACT PROVIDING CERTAIN ADULT ADOPTED PERSONS WITH ACCESS TO INFORMATION IN THEIR ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATES."

1 Strike lines 23 to 34, inclusive, in their entirety and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(c) Regardless of the date parental rights were terminated, any
4 person who was born on or after October 1, 2006, whose adoption was
5 finalized on or after October 1, 2006, and for whom a new certificate of
6 birth was established on or after October 1, 2006, pursuant to section 7-
7 53, as amended by this act, because of the adoption, or if such person is
8 deceased, an authorized applicant as defined in subparagraph (D) of
9 subdivision (3) of section 45a-743, may apply for and receive a copy of
10 (1) the person's sealed original birth certificate or record pursuant to
11 section 7-51, as amended by this act, and (2) any contact preference
12 form attached to the sealed original birth certificate or record pursuant
13 to section 7-51, as amended by this act. Nothing in this subsection shall
14 be construed to limit such person's or authorized applicant's access to

15 information pursuant to this part."

16 Strike lines 101 to 111, inclusive, in their entirety and substitute the
17 following in lieu thereof:

18 "(2) The department shall provide access to and issuance of a copy
19 of a sealed original birth record or certificate marked with the same
20 notation required for such records under subsection (c) of section 7-53,
21 as amended by this act, to any person twenty-one years of age or older
22 who was born on or after October 1, 2006, whose adoption was
23 finalized on or after October 1, 2006, and for whom a new certificate of
24 birth was established on or after October 1, 2006, pursuant to section 7-
25 53, as amended by this act, because of the adoption, or if the person is
26 deceased, an authorized applicant as defined in subparagraph (D) of
27 subdivision (3) of section 45a-743, provided the department is satisfied
28 as to the identity of the person or authorized applicant requesting the
29 record or certificate."
