**"AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE OF ELECTRONIC DEFENSE WEAPONS."**

1      Strike section 501 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu  
2 thereof:

3      "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2006*) (a) Any person who  
4 possesses a firearm, as defined in section 53a-3 of the general statutes,  
5 that is stolen from such person or that such person loses shall report  
6 such theft or loss to the organized local police department for the town  
7 in which the theft or loss occurred or, if such town does not have an  
8 organized local police department, to the state police troop having  
9 jurisdiction for such town, not later than seventy-two hours after such  
10 person knew of such theft or loss. Such department or troop shall  
11 forthwith forward a copy of such report to the Commissioner of Public  
12 Safety.

13      (b) If any person fails to make a report as required by subsection (a)

14 of this section within the prescribed time period and the firearm of  
15 such person is subsequently recovered and determined to have been  
16 used in the commission of a crime, upon final disposition of the  
17 criminal action and notwithstanding the provisions of section 54-36a of  
18 the general statutes, such firearm shall be destroyed and any permit to  
19 carry such firearm held by such person shall be revoked by the  
20 Department of Public Safety."
