**"AN ACT CONCERNING CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECKS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 12-568a of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2006*):

5 (a) The Division of Special Revenue shall adopt regulations, in  
6 accordance with chapter 54, for the purpose of assuring the integrity of  
7 the state lottery, concerning the regulation of the state lottery under  
8 the operation and management of the Connecticut Lottery  
9 Corporation. Such regulations shall include: (1) The licensing of  
10 employees of the Connecticut Lottery Corporation and any person or  
11 business organization awarded the primary contract by said  
12 corporation to provide facilities, components, goods or services which  
13 are necessary for the operation of the activities authorized by chapter  
14 229a; (2) the approval of procedures of the corporation; (3) the time

15 period for complying with the regulations governing said approval of  
16 procedures; (4) offerings of lottery games; (5) minimum prize payouts  
17 and payments; (6) regulation of lottery sales agents including  
18 qualifications for licensure and grounds for license suspension and  
19 revocation; (7) assurance of the integrity of the state lottery including  
20 the computer gaming system, computer internal control and system  
21 testing; and (8) limitations on advertising and marketing content to  
22 assure public information as to the odds of winning the lottery and the  
23 prohibition of sales of tickets to minors.

24 (b) The regulations adopted pursuant to subdivision (6) of  
25 subsection (a) of this section shall include a requirement that each  
26 applicant for an initial license as a lottery sales agent and an employee  
27 designated by the applicant to oversee lottery sales for the applicant  
28 submit to state and national criminal history records checks conducted  
29 in accordance with section 29-17a of the 2006 supplement to the  
30 general statutes before such license is issued.

31 Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) Notwithstanding the  
32 deadline for the presentation to the Connecticut Lottery Corporation of  
33 a winning lottery ticket to claim a prize for any Lotto lottery game, any  
34 person who presents any winning Lotto lottery ticket no later than  
35 seventy-two hours after the end of the time period for presenting  
36 claims for any lottery game expiring on or after July 1, 1996, may file a  
37 claim for such prize until August 1, 2006. Upon such application, said  
38 corporation shall award such prize as follows: Ninety per cent of such  
39 prize shall be paid to such person, and ten per cent of such prize shall  
40 be paid to the Division of Special Revenue.

41 (b) The Division of Special Revenue shall use any funds received  
42 pursuant to subsection (a) of this section to (1) conduct state and  
43 national criminal history records checks pursuant to section 12-568a of  
44 the general statutes, as amended by this act."
