"AN ACT CONCERNING GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective December 31, 2006, and applicable to*
4 *elections held on or after said date*) Notwithstanding any provision of the
5 general statutes, in any primary campaign in which the provisions of
6 subparagraph (A) of subdivision (1) of subsection (e) of section 9-705
7 of the 2006 supplement to the general statutes or subparagraph (A) of
8 subdivision (1) of subsection (f) of said section 9-705 are utilized to
9 increase the amount of the primary grant to the qualified candidate
10 committee of the dominant major party candidate, the qualified
11 candidate committee of the non-dominant major party candidate shall
12 receive a supplemental grant from the Citizens' Election Fund in an
13 amount equivalent to the respective increase in the primary grant to
14 the qualified candidate committee of the dominant major party

15 candidate."
