"AN ACT CONCERNING GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 9-333m of the 2006 supplement to
4 the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
5 thereof (*Effective from passage*):

6 (a) No individual shall make a contribution or contributions to, for
7 the benefit of, or pursuant to the authorization or request of, a
8 candidate or a committee supporting or opposing any candidate's
9 campaign for nomination at a primary, or any candidate's campaign
10 for election, to the office of (1) Governor, in excess of [three thousand
11 five hundred] two hundred fifty dollars; (2) Lieutenant Governor,
12 Secretary of the State, Treasurer, Comptroller or Attorney General, in

13 excess of two [thousand] hundred fifty dollars; (3) chief executive
14 officer of a town, city or borough, in excess of [one thousand] two
15 hundred fifty dollars; (4) state senator or probate judge, in excess of
16 [one thousand] two hundred fifty dollars; or (5) state representative or
17 any other office of a municipality not previously included in this
18 subsection, in excess of two hundred fifty dollars. The limits imposed
19 by this subsection shall be applied separately to primaries and
20 elections."
