Substitute House Bill No. 5528

House of Representatives, May 7, 2007

The Committee on Appropriations reported through REP. MERRILL of the 54th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING THE TOWN AID ROAD PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Secretary of the Office of Policy
- 2 and Management shall review the current formula, set forth by part IIa
- 3 of chapter 240 of the general statutes, used to distribute Town Aid for
- 4 Roads funds, and shall submit a recommendation for a revised
- 5 formula to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
- 6 having cognizance of matters relating to transportation not later than
- 7 January 16, 2008.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section
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TRA *Joint Favorable C/R* APP

APP *Joint Favorable Subst.*

Explanation

The bill requires the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management (OPM) to review the current formula for the Town Aid for Roads grant and submit recommendations for a revised formula to the Transportation Committee by January 16, 2008. It is anticipated that OPM can perform these duties within the normal budgetary resources of the agency, and results in no fiscal impact.
