Senate Bill No. 557

Senate, April 3, 2007

The Committee on Government Administration and Elections reported through SEN. SLOSSBERG of the 14th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT VALIDATING THE NOVEMBER 3, 2003, REFERENDUM IN THE TOWN OF MANCHESTER REGARDING CERTAIN PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding any provision of
2 the general statutes or any special act, charter or ordinance, the vote
3 cast by the electors and voters of the town of Manchester at the
4 referendum held on November 3, 2003, relating to approval of an
5 appropriation for construction of road and sidewalk improvements,
6 bridge design and repair, traffic signal upgrades, storm drainage and
7 extension of the Charter Oak Greenway and the authorization of the
8 issuance of bonds, notes and temporary notes and the acceptance of
9 grants and other available funds to defray said appropriation,
10 otherwise valid except for the failure to publish the correct dollar value
11 of the appropriation and bond authorization in the notice of the
12 referendum, is validated. All acts, votes and proceedings of the officers
13 and officials of the town of Manchester pertaining to or taken in

14 reliance on said referendum, otherwise valid except for the failure to
15 publish the correct dollar value of the appropriation and bond
16 authorization in the notice of the referendum, are validated and
17 effective as of the date taken.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
