***AN ACT CONCERNING INCREASED ACCESS TO THE STATE'S  
ASSISTED LIVING PILOT PROJECTS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1       Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 17b-365 of the general statutes is  
2       repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*  
3       *1, 2007*):

4       (a) The Commissioner of Social Services may, within available  
5       appropriations, establish and operate a pilot program to allow  
6       individuals to receive assisted living services, provided by an assisted  
7       living services agency licensed by the Department of Public Health in  
8       accordance with chapter 368v. In order to be eligible for the program,  
9       an individual shall: (1) Reside in a managed residential community, as  
10      defined by the regulations of the Department of Public Health; (2) be  
11      ineligible to receive assisted living services under any other assisted  
12      living pilot program established by the General Assembly; and (3) be  
13      eligible for services under the Medicaid waiver portion of the  
14      Connecticut home-care program for the elderly established under  
15      section 17b-342. The total number of individuals enrolled in said pilot  
16      program, when combined with the total number of individuals  
17      enrolled in the pilot program established pursuant to section 17b-366,
