**AN ACT CONCERNING THE INCLUSION OF THE COST OF
RELOCATION IN ELECTRIC UTILITY RATES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2007*) The Department of Public Utility
2 Control shall conduct a study on how to allocate or apportion the
3 benefits of relocating an electric distribution company, as defined in
4 section 16-1 of the general statutes, in such a way that all customers of
5 the company are held harmless in relation to their property taxes. The
6 department shall report the findings of said study to the joint standing
7 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
8 relating to energy on or before February 1, 2008.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
