**AN ACT CONCERNING A TAX CREDIT AGAINST THE PERSONAL
INCOME TAX FOR PERSONS SEVENTY YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 229 of the general statutes be amended to provide a tax
- 2 credit in the amount of five hundred dollars to persons seventy years
- 3 of age or older.

Statement of Purpose:

To have a tax credit on the state income tax form for individuals
seventy years of age or older.
