AN ACT CONCERNING THE MONITORING OF SEXUAL OFFENDERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 969 of the general statutes, concerning the registration
2 of sexual offenders, be amended to require sexual offenders to
3 reregister twice each year, to provide enhanced criminal penalties for
4 sexual offenders who fail to reregister, fail to respond to address
5 verification, fail to report in person or provide false information to law
6 enforcement officials, to provide criminal penalties for persons who
7 harbor or conceal sexual offenders who have failed to register or
8 reregister and are attempting to elude law enforcement officials, and to
9 require the electronic monitoring of the location of certain sexual
10 offenders released into the community, and that sufficient funds be
11 appropriated to implement these actions.

Statement of Purpose:

To revise the reporting requirements for registered sexual offenders and the penalties for sexual offenders who fail to comply with those requirements, and establish penalties for persons who harbor or conceal the whereabouts of sexual offenders who are not complying with the law.
